



This project will provide a part-time “Wildfire Safety Liaison” for our area to over 2 to 3 years to provide structural assessment training, structural assessments, and education/outreach.

Another important part of this project is the “standardized data management strategy” which will include a mobile data collection tool and associated analytics, and will be integrated into our Fine-Scale Risk Mapping project above. This program area will be managed by Jensen Hughes. Both Jensen Hughes and OVFSC hopes that we can draw in insurance participation and funding, including the possibility of a one or two major carriers participating to test out new risk modeling for wildfire risk rating. Participation and/or funding from other professional organizations and corporations will be sought.

6. California Regional Summit \$535,352.69

- This large event will be managed overall by VCRCDC with a significant portion of the funding going to a nonprofit, Coastal Quest, to set up and run the 3-day Summit, in either Ventura or Los Angeles County. This event will draw organizations and agencies from across the state to share and learn from each other. We will be participating as presenters and hosts, with our costs covered by the grant.

Grant Management: VCRCDC, as the lead agency, will receive \$73,505.55 for grant management and facilitation.
